



CITIZENSHIP

You are asked to verify your status as a citizen or permanent resident of the United States. Acceptable documentation includes one of the following:

U.S. citizen

*Bring one of the following **original** documents to the financial aid office:

- U.S. birth certificate or a copy of your U.S. passport or passport card
- Certificate of Birth Abroad (FS-240, FS-545, or DS-1350)

Naturalized citizen

*Bring one of the following **original** documents to the financial aid office:

- U.S. passport or passport card
- Certificate of Birth Abroad (FS-240, FS-545, or DS-1350)
- Certificate of Citizenship (N-560, N-561)
- Certificate of Naturalization (N-550, N-570)

U.S. permanent resident

*Bring one of the following **original** documents to the financial aid office:

- Alien Registration Receipt/Resident Alien/Permanent Resident/Conditional Resident
- Permanent Resident card (I-551, I-94, I-94A)
- Foreign passport with I-551 endorsements
- Arrival/Departure Record I-94 with I-551 endorsements

*If the original document cannot be presented in person to a Financial Aid Counselor, you must complete the [Citizenship Certification Form](#) in the presence of a notary.
