



Selective Service

Federal law requires that all male recipients of federal financial aid comply with Selective Service Registration provisions. Since Selective Service has not been able to confirm your registration or your exemption status, you must complete one of the following actions. Once you have indicated which condition best applies to you, be sure to send in all required documentation.

Condition	Action
I am required to register with Selective Service. (Visit www.sss.gov for registration requirements)	Please send in one of the following documents <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. A copy of your Selective Service Registration Card b. A copy of your Selective Service Registration acknowledgement (available after registration with Selective Service at www.sss.gov). c. A copy of your DD214 (Member Request Copy 4) "Certificate of Release or Discharged from Active Duty" d. Login to the FAFSA on the web (www.fafsa.gov) and correct your FAFSA checking the 'register me' indicator for question #22. The federal processor will forward your information to Selective Service for registration. This option can only be used if you are a male between the ages of 18 to 25.
I did not register with Selective Service because I entered the United States for the first time after my 26 th birthday.	Please send in the following documents: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. A statement that explains when you came into the U.S. b. Proof of immigration date into the U.S. from an entry date stamp on the I-94 form or in the passport, or a letter from the USCIS indicating the entry date.
I did not register with Selective Service because I was a visa holder between the ages of 18-25 year old.	Please send in a copy of a student visa form I-20, other valid U.S. passport visa stamp with expiration date (the dates must be from entry to the U.S. until after the male turned 26 years of age).
I was required to but did not register with Selective Service before my 26 th birthday.	Please send in the following documents <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. A copy of your Selective Service Status Information Letter. Visit www.sss.gov/fsmen.htm for additional information about this letter or call 847-688-6888. b. A personal statement explaining why you did not register with Selective Service along with documentation supporting your statement

Only males are required to register. Whether a person is male or female is a matter for medical determination. If you question whether or not you need to register, call the Selective Service at 847-688-6888 for a Status Information Letter.
