# Adult students\* (No prior college experience)

---

## Titanium Scholarship

**\$6,000** | 3.75+ high school GPA OR 3.0+ GPA with a 28 ACT or 1320 SAT

## Platinum Scholarship

**\$4,000** | 3.5+ high school GPA OR 3.0+ GPA with a 23 ACT or 1140 SAT

## Gold Scholarship

**\$3,000** | 3.2+ high school GPA OR 3.0+ GPA with a 21 ACT or 1070 SAT

## Silver Scholarship

**\$2,000** | 2.8+ high school GPA OR 2.0+ GPA with a 21 ACT or 1070 SAT OR qualifying test score (Accuplacer) OR GED of 530+

**\$6,000** | 3.75+ Transfer GPA with 15+ transferable credits\*\*

## Transfer Student Grant

**20% off tuition** | Awarded based on 1+ transferable credits

## Partner Tuition Grants

## Housing Grant

**\$500 - \$1,000** | Available based on financial need

**\$1,000** | 3.0 CGPA from a bachelor's degree

The scholarship covers the costs of tuition, books, fees, a study abroad experience, on-campus housing and meal plans | 3.75 GPA and 1430 SAT or 31 ACT + essay requirement\*

**Up to full tuition** | 2.0 GPA + application requirements

## Si Se Puede

### Cesar E. Chavez Scholarship

**Up to full tuition** | 2.0 GPA + application requirements

## University President's Scholarship\*\*

**\$10,000** | 3.9+ GPA OR 3.5 GPA with a 1400 SAT or 30 ACT

## Excellence Scholarship

**\$8,000** | 3.5+ GPA OR 3.0 GPA with 1140 SAT or 23 ACT, OR BPA, DECA, HOSA, or Skills USA national top 10 finisher

## Achievement Scholarship

**\$6,500** | 3.0 to 3.49 GPA OR 2.5 GPA with 1070 SAT or 21 ACT, OR BPA, DECA, HOSA, or Skills USA state competition participant

## Signature Scholarship

**\$5,000** | Admitted with a GPA less than 3.0

## Partner Tuition Grants

Varies based on partnership agreement

## Foundation Scholarship

Based on individual scholarship criteria and availability of funds. Scholarships funded by private donations to the Davenport University Foundation.

## Housing Grant

**\$500 - \$1,000** | Available based on financial need

\*The best option will be awarded to you based on qualifications
