Scholarships and grants

Adult students* (No prior college experience)

Titanium Scholarship

\$6,000 | 3.75+ high school GPA OR 3.0+ GPA with a 28 ACT or 1320 SAT

Platinum Scholarship

\$4,000 | 3.5+ high school GPA OR 3.0+ GPA with a 23 ACT or 1140 SAT

Gold Scholarship

\$3,000 | 3.2+ high school GPA OR 3.0+ GPA with a 21 ACT or 1070 SAT

Silver Scholarship

\$2,000 | 2.8+ high school GPA OR 2.0+ GPA with a 21 ACT or 1070 SAT OR qualifying test score (Accuplacer) OR GED of 530+

Panther Distinguished Transfer Scholarship

\$6,500 | Transfer 3.5 GPA or higher + application requirement

Panther Honors Transfer Scholarship

\$5,500 | Transfer 3.0 — 3.49 GPA + application requirement

Panther Transfer Scholarship

\$4,500 | Transfer 2.99 or below GPA + application requirement

Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship (stackable)

\$1,500 | Member of Phi Theta Kappa + application requirement

\$10,000 | 3.9+ GPA OR 3.5 GPA with a 1400 SAT or 30 ACT

Excellence Scholarship

\$8,000 I 3.5+ GPA OR 3.0 GPA with 1140 SAT or 23 ACT, OR BPA, DECA, HOSA, or Skills USA national top 10 finisher

Achievement Scholarship

\$6,500 | 3.0 to 3.49 GPA OR 2.5 GPA with 1070 SAT or 21 ACT, OR BPA, DECA, HOSA, or Skills USA state competition participant

Signature Scholarship

\$5,000 | Admitted with a GPA less than 3.0

Panther Grant

\$4,000 | Grants available based on financial need

Partner Tuition Grants

Varies based on partnership agreement
