## High school seniors – Quick facts for your application process

### Pathway to success

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing, Pre-Licensure program (BSN-PL)
- Designed for students who have chosen to be a professional nurse
- Preparation for the NCLEX-RN certification. In fact, Davenport graduates pass the NCLEX exams at higher rates than others
- Davenport guarantees students the necessary education and connections to land a job within six months after graduation
- Apply during your senior year. An acceptance to Davenport's nursing program means a guaranteed seat, and you'll begin nursing classes right away

- 1 Apply for admission to Davenport (Program: Bachelors seeking Undecided CoHP - Nursing) at [davenport.edu/apply](http://davenport.edu/apply)
- 2 Send high school transcripts and SAT/ACT scores for Davenport acceptance
- 3 Submit Nursing CAS application at [davenport.edu/nursingapplication](http://davenport.edu/nursingapplication)

\* If your GPA is below 3.0, you can enroll in 9 courses in your freshman year at Davenport to follow the adult and transfer direct admit pathway. If you achieve a 3.0 GPA in each course, you will be directly admitted into Davenport's BSN-PL program.
