Alternative Route to Teacher Certification Program

All coursework for this graduate certificate program is based on graduate-level instruction, therefore all program participants must possess a bachelor's degree. Students who have a bachelor's degree and have passed the Michigan Test for Teacher Certification in their discipline area will also receive an interim teaching certificate (along with this education graduate certificate) that allows them to teach in Michigan schools while they fulfill credential requirements.

This urban education graduate certificate also opens doors to urban education career opportunities for current educators seeking an additional endorsement or certification.

While this program will equip students to teach diverse populations in urban schools, the knowledge and skills they acquire will prepare them to succeed in any primary or secondary educational setting.

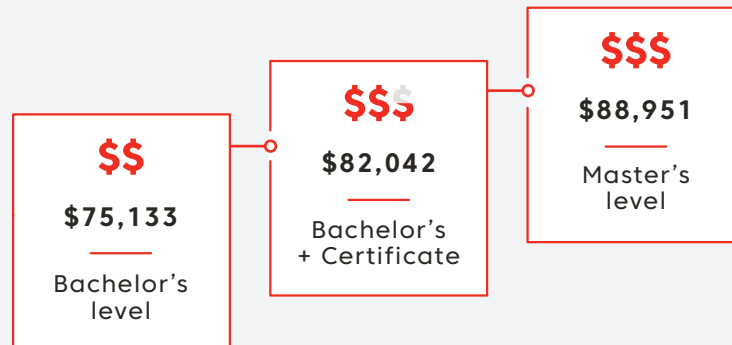
