# **Transfer Students**

# Panther Distinguished Transfer Scholarship

\$6,500 | Transfer 3.5 GPA or higher + application requirement

## Panther Honors Transfer Scholarship

\$5,500 | Transfer 3.0 — 3.49 GPA + application requirements

### Panther Transfer Scholarship

\$4,500 | Transfer 2.99 or below GPA + application requirements

### Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship

\$1,500 | Member of Phi Theta Kappa + application requirements

# **Foundation Scholarship**

Based on individual scholarship criteria and availability of funds — scholarships are funded by private donations to the Davenport University Foundation

## **Partner Tuition Grants**

Varies based on the partnership agreement

There is no minimum transfer credit requirement to receive a scholarship.
