Foundation Scholarship

Based on individual scholarship criteria and availability of funds — scholarships are funded by private donations to the Davenport University Foundation

Partner Tuition Grants

Varies based on the partnership agreement

There is no minimum transfer credit requirement to receive a scholarship.

Financial Aid Steps

1. Get accepted to DU

Submit your application if you have not done so already through davenport.edu/apply. Only accepted students will receive an official financial aid package.

2. FAFSA

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) will be available to complete in Dec. Please file as soon as you are able.

3. DU Award Package

A financial aid award package will be mailed once we receive your FAFSA.

4. Additional Awards

Admissions and financial aid will assist you in finding additional aid to make your education affordable.
