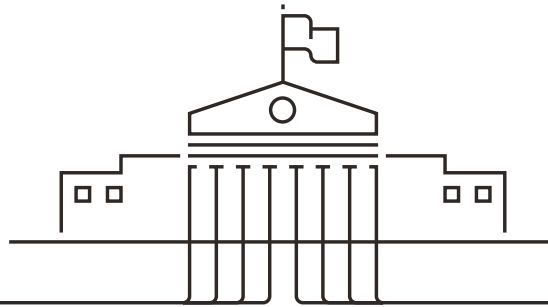

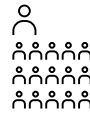

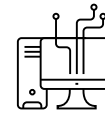
Many students who complete internships are offered jobs prior to graduation

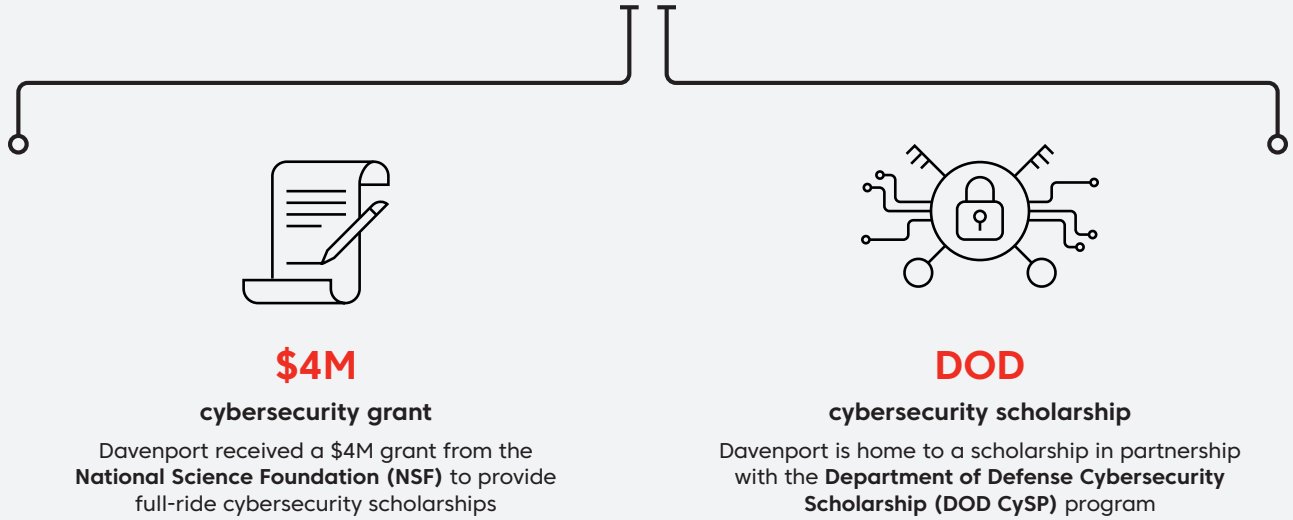

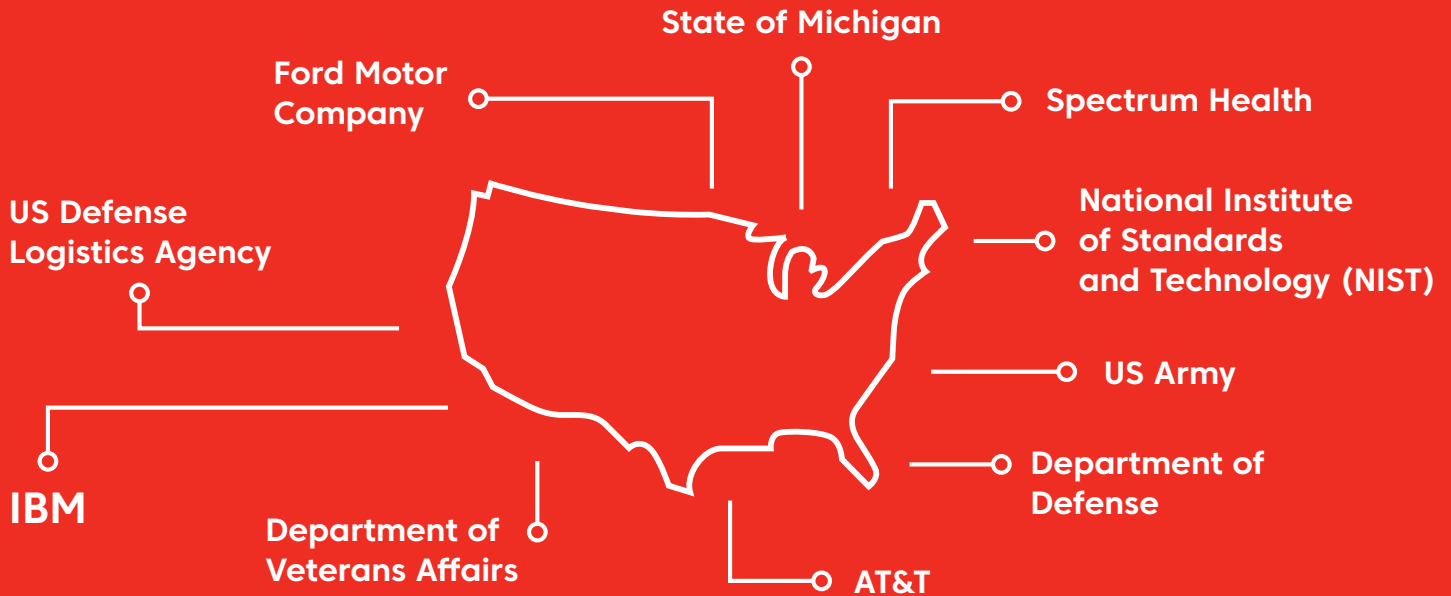
