Gerald R. Ford Memorial Scholarship

The scholarship covers the costs of tuition, books, fees, a study abroad experience, on-campus housing and meal plans 3.75 GPA + essay requirements

Martin Luther King Inherit the Dream Scholarship

Up to full tuition | 2.0 GPA + application requirements

Si Se Puede Cesar E. Chavez Scholarship

Up to full tuition | 2.0 GPA + application requirements

University President's Scholarship**

\$10,000 | 3.9+ GPA OR 3.5 GPA with a 1400 SAT or 30 ACT

Excellence Scholarship

\$8,000 | 3.5+ GPA OR 3.0 GPA with 1140 SAT or 23 ACT, OR BPA, DECA, HOSA or Skills USA national top 10 finisher

Achievement Scholarship

\$6,500 | 3.0 to 3.49 GPA OR 2.5 GPA with 1070 SAT or 21 ACT, OR BPA, DECA, HOSA or Skills USA state competition participant

Signature Scholarship

\$5,000 | Admitted with a GPA less than 3.0

Foundation Scholarship

Based on individual scholarship criteria and availability of funds — scholarships are funded by private donations to the Davenport University Foundation

Panther Grant

\$4,000 | Grants available based on financial need

Partner Tuition Grants

Varies on partnership agreement

Michigan Achievement Scholarship

The scholarship is available based on financial need and the value will be up to \$4,000 per year. This would be in addition to other academic scholarships and grants.

*Graduated high school within the last two years.

**Limited to only five new students per academic year.

Financial Aid Steps

1. Get accepted to DU

Submit your application and get accepted by Dec. 31 for maximum scholarship consideration. Only accepted students will receive an official financial aid package.

2. FAFSA

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) should be available to complete in December. This is new for the 2024-25 academic year only. Please file as soon as you are able.

3. DU Award Package

A financial aid award package will be mailed once we receive your FAFSA.

4. Additional Awards

Admissions and financial aid will assist you in finding additional aid to make your education affordable.
